ORDINANCE NO. 82080

AN ORDINANCE providing for the extension into deeper water of the existing sewer outfall in West Lander Street as contemplated by Ordinance No. 74615 and appropriating money therefor from the Seattle Sewer Bonds 1946 Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Board of Public Works be and it is authorized and directed to prepare plans and specifications for and to proceed with the construction of the following sewer outfall extension into deeper water as contemplated by Ordinance No. 74615, to wit:

Extend the sewer outfall in West Lander Street, from its present terminus in the East Waterway northwesterly approximately 184 feet and do such other work as may be necessary in connection therewith.

Said work shall be effected by the awarding of a contract or contracts therefor or, in the discretion of said Board, the same or any part thereof may be done by day labor.

Section 2. That the sum of Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated from the Seattle Sewer Bonds 1946 Fund, for the purpose set forth in Section 1 hereof.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 3 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

Gentlemen:

For some time the discharge of the 96-foot sewer in West Lander Street at the East Waterway has been creating an extremely undesirable condition for the Lander Street Terminal of the Port of Seattle.

Examination of the situation discloses that complaints to this department by the Port of Seattle have been justified.

The extension of the West Lander Street outfall was authorized by Ordinance No. 74615 as a part of the work to be done from the 1946 Sewer Bond Funds, but was not accomplished at the time that other outfalls similarly authorized were extended in 1949.

During the months of July and August, tides will be extremely favorable for the extension of this outfall approximately 184 feet to a point 20 feet deeper than the present outlet.

If this work is done during this period of favorable tides, we believe that the work can be accomplished for \$8,000.00, considerably less than if it is performed during normal tides.

We therefore recommend that this work be authorized and that \$8,000.00 be appropriated from the Seattle Sewer Bonds 1946 Funds for this purpose.

A Council Bill providing for same is transmitted herewith for your approval.
