Section 1. That

WEST BLEWETT STREET from a line 50 feet northerly of and concentric with the center line of the Northern Pacific Railway Main Track as now constructed across Blocks 24, 14 and 13, Ross Addition, to the southeasterly line of Jesse Avenue, and from 6th Avenue West to 8th Avenue West; and
BRAWLEY STREET from 6th Avenue West to the southwesterly line of the Lake Washington Ship usual right of way,

be and the same are hereby vacated, reserving to the City of Seattle the right to reconstruct, maintain and operate the existing overhead utilities until such time as the beneficiaries of said vacation arrange with the owners of said utilities for their removal. (To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)
