ORDINANCE NO. 83414

AN ORDINANCE accepting a deed from the State of Washington to portions of Block "C", Brooklyn Supplemental Addition, and other properties, for street purposes, and placing the same under the jurisdiction of the City Engineer.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the deed, executed by the Governor of the State of Washington, on August 25, 1954, conveying to the City of Seattle all its right, title and interest, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 133, Laws of 1953, and in accordance with judgment and decree of the Superior Court of the State of Washington for King County, Cause No. 471129, dated July 27, 1954, to the following described property heretofore named "Campus Parkway" by Ordinance No. 76063, situate in the City of Seattle, King County, Washington, to-wit:

The South half of Lots 11 and 29, and all of Lots 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 24, 25, 26, 27 and 28 in Block "C", Brooklyn Supplemental Addition to the City of Seattle, as per plat thereof recorded in Volume 9 of Plats at Page 20, records of King County; EXCEPT portions of said Lots 13, 14, 15, 16 and 24 condemned or conveyed for streets.

All of Lots 5, 6, 7, 8, 17, 18, 19 and 20, in Block 20, Brooklyn Addition to Seattle, as per plat thereof recorded in Volume 7 of Plats at Page 32, records of King County.

All of Lots 5, 6, 7, 8, 17, 18, 19 and 20, in Block 21, said Brooklyn Addition to Seattle.

All of Lots 5, 6, 7, 8, 17, 18, 19, 20 and the South 5 feet of Lot 21, in Block 22, said Brooklyn Addition to Seattle; ALSO a portion of Lot 4 in said Block 22 described as follows: Beginning at the Southeast corner of said Lot 4; thence North along the East line of said Lot 4, a distance of 18 feet; thence Southwesterly to a point on the South line of said Lot 4 and 6.71 feet West of the point of beginning; thence East 6.71 feet to the point of beginning.

All of Lots 5, 6, 7, 8, 18, 19 and 20, in Block 23, said Brooklyn Addition to Seattle; ALSO Lot 17 less the South 5 inches thereof, in said Block 23; ALSO a portion of Lot 4 in said Block 23 described as follows; Beginning at the

Southeast corner of said Lot 4; thence North along the East line of said Lot 4 a distance of 18 feet; thence Southwesterly to a point on the South line of said Lot 4 and 5.76 feet West of the point of beginning; thence East 5.76 feet to the point of beginning.

All of Lots 5, 6, 7, 8, 19 and 20, in Block 24, said Brooklyn Addition to ...; ALSO the North Half of Lot 9, less the South 5 inches thereof, in said Block 24;

be and the same is hereby accepted for street purposes, and placed under the jurisdiction of the City Engineer.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

Gentlemen:


We transmit herewith for your approval a council bill accepting a deed from the State of Washington to the various properties included in Campus Parkway.

This deed was requested from the State of Washington in December of 1953 and the executed deed has just been received in this office. It was necessary for the State to get a judgment and decree in the Superior Court in order that this property might be transferred from the jurisdiction of the State to the jurisdiction of the City.

This deed will give the City complete jurisdiction over the entire right of way of Campus Parkway as compared to the limited jurisdiction it had before over only the improved surfaces.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
