BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following streets and avenues be, and the same are hereby renamed, defined and established in accordance with the recommendation of the Board of Public Works (File No. 225311) as follows:

West 90th Place as platted in Olympic Manor Div. No. 2 Addition from West 90th Street to 23rd Avenue Northwest, be WEST 89TH PLACE;

Northlake Avenue as existing from Aurora Avenue to 1st Avenue Northeast, be NORTHLAKE WAY:
