AN ORDINANCE accepting the awards for property in Allendale Addition and vicinity for a site for a reservoir in the Bitter Lake area, under Ordinance No. 83429, King County Superior Court Cause No. 479044; and making an appropriation from the Water Fund therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the condemnation awards as set forth in the verdicts entered on June 16, 1955, in the matter of the acquisition by condemnation of certain property in Allendale Addition and vicinity for a site for a reservoir in the Bitter Lake area, under Ordinance No. 83429, King County Superior Court Cause No. 479044, are hereby accepted.

Section 2. That for the payment of such awards, interest and costs thereof, there is hereby appropriated Seventy Six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$76,500.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, from the Water Fund; that the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to pay the necessary moneys into court by warrant, and the City Treasurer is authorized to pay the same.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.




