ORDINANCE NO. 84703

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Engineering Department; authorizing expenditures for dredging of the area in the vicinity of the Hanford Street Sewer outfall; making an appropriation from the Emergency Fund and declaring the emergency therefor.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Board of Public Works is authorized to prepare plans and specifications for and proceed with the dredging of the area in the vicinity of the Hanford Street Sewer outfall, as contemplated by C. F. 228190. Said improvement may be effected by the letting of a contract or contracts therefor or the same or any part thereof may be accomplished by day labor in the discretion of the Board of Public Works.

Section 2. That in order to effectuate such purpose the sum of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Emergency Fund and the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants therefor.

Section 3. WHEREAS, the appropriation made in Section 2 hereof is to meet actual necessary expenditures of the Engineering Department for which no appropriation has been made due to causes which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of making the 1955 Budget of said department; Now, Therefore, in accordance with RCW 35.32.130 by reason of the facts above stated and the emergency which is hereby declared to exist, this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon the approval or the signing of the same by the Mayor, or the passage of the same over his veto as provided by the Charter of the City.

PASSED by unanimous vote of the City Council the 12 day of December, 1955, and signed by me in open session in authentication of its passage this 12 day of December, 1955.
