ORDINANCE NO. 84116

AN ORDINANCE relating to and providing for the acquisition by condemnation of rights of way for drainage purposes over and across Lot 38, Block 6, Craven's Division of Green Lake Addition, and Lot 39, Block 10, Greenwood Park 2nd Addition; providing for payment therefor; and repealing Ordinance No. 84328.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That public necessity and convenience demand that rights of way for drainage purposes be acquired by condemnation over and across the following described properties situate in King County, Washington, to wit:

The east 6 feet of the west 20 feet of Lot 38, Block 6, Craven's Division of Green Lake Addition, as recorded in Volume 4 of King County Plats at Page 3; also

The east 4 feet of Lot 39, Block 10, Greenwood Park 2nd Addition, as recorded in Volume 17 of King County Plats at Page 56;

and that only such rights in the lands above-described shall be acquired as shall be necessary for the construction, reconstruction, operation and maintenance of said drains, reserving unto the owner thereof the right to use said properties in any way and for any purpose not inconsistent with the rights hereby authorized to be acquired.

Section 2. That the entire cost of the improvement provided for herein shall be paid by local improvement assessment as provided for by Chapter 364, Laws of the State of Washington, Regular Session for 1955, as part of the assessment to be levied for the improvement known as "Alley in Block 3, Greenwood Park Annex, et al", under Local Improvement District No. 6096 as authorized by Ordinance No. 84116.

Section 3. That the Corporation Counsel be and he is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings in the manner provided by law necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency)

Section 4. That in conducting said condemnation proceedings, the Corporation Counsel be and he is hereby authorized to enter into stipulations for the purpose of minimizing damages.

Section 5. That Ordinance No. 84328 entitled:

"AN ORDINANCE relating to and providing for the acquisition by condemnation of rights-of-way for drainage purposes over and across Lot 38, Block 6, Craven's Division of Green Lake Addition, and Lot 11, Block 10, Greenwood Park 2nd Addition, and providing for the payment therefor."

approved August 10, 1955, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.



ORDINANCE NO. 8418

AN ORDINANCE relating to and providing for the acquisition by condemnation of rights of way for drainage purposes over and across Lot 38, Block 6, Craven's Division of Green Lake Addition, and Lot 39, Block 10, Greenwood Park 2nd Addition; providing for payment therefor; and repealing Ordinance No. 84328.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That public necessity and convenience demand that rights of way for drainage purposes be acquired by condemnation over and across the following described properties situate in King County, Washington, to-wit:

The east 4 feet of the west 20 feet of Lot 38, Block 6, Craven's Division of Green Lake Addition, as recorded in Volume 4 of King County Plats at Page 3; also

The east 4 feet of Lot 39, Block 10, Greenwood Park 2nd Addition, as recorded in Volume 17 of King County Plats at Page 56;

and that only such rights in the lands above-described shall be acquired as shall be necessary for the construction, reconstruction, operation and maintenance of said drains, reserving unto the owner thereof the right to use said properties in any way and for any purpose not inconsistent with the rights hereby authorized to be acquired.

Section 2. That the entire cost of the improvement provided for herein shall be paid by local improvement assessment as provided for by Chapter 364, Laws of the State of Washington, Regular Session for 1955, as part of the assessment to be levied for the improvement known as "Alley in Block 3, Greenwood Park Annex, et al." under Local Improvement District No. 6098 as authorized by Ordinance No. 84116.

Section 3. That the Corporation Counsel be and he is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings in the manner provided by law necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 4. That in conducting said condemnation proceedings, the Corporation Counsel be and he is hereby authorized, to enter into stipulations for the purpose of minimizing damages.

Section 5. That Ordinance No. 84328 entitled:

"AN ORDINANCE relating to and providing for the acquisition by condemnation of rights-of-way for drainage purposes over and across Lot 38, Block 6, Craven's Division of Green Lake Addition, and Lot 39, Block 10, Greenwood Park 2nd Addition, and providing for the payment therefor."

approved August 10, 1955, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
