BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That upon approval of this ordinance, the City Engineer is authorized to negotiate and acquire by purchase from the owners thereof the following described property to-wit:

Lots 7 and 8, Block 6, Terry's 5th Addition to the City of Seattle, as recorded in Volume 2 of King County Plats, Page 55; Also

Lot 8, Block 7, Plummer's Addition to the City of Seattle, as recorded in Volume 1 of King County Plats, Page 133;

for use in connection with the City of Seattle's Charles Street Maintenance Headquarters as contemplated in Comptroller's File No. 228234, for the sum of not to exceed Fifteen Thousand and NO/100 Dollars (\$15,000.00)

On execution and delivery by said owners to the escrow agent of warranty deeds therefor, approved as to description by the City Engineer and approved as to form by the Corporation Counsel, payment of the purchase price into escrow is hereby authorized. Upon delivery of owners' policies of title insurance, showing the title to the property to be vested in the City of Seattle, free and clear of all encumbrances, payment to said owners by such escrow agent is hereby authorized.

Section 2. On execution and delivery by said owners to the escrow agent of warranty deeds therefor, approved as to description by the City Engineer and approved as to form by the Corporation Counsel, payment of the purchase price into escrow is hereby authorized. Upon delivery of owners' policies of title insurance, showing the title to the property to be vested in the City of Seattle, free and clear of all encumbrances, payment to said owners by such escrow agent is hereby authorized.

Section 2. That in order to effectuate the purpose as set forth in Section 1 hereof, the sum of Fifteen Thousand and NO/100 Dollars (\$15,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated from the Emergency Fund, to be reimbursable by like appropriation, which is hereby made from the City Street Fund; and the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants therefor.


Section 3. WHEREAS the appropriation from the Emergency Fund made in Section 2 hereof is to meet actual necessary expenditures of the Engineering Department for which no appropriation has been made due to causes which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of making the 1956 Budget of the Engineering Department;

Now, Therefore, in accordance with RCW 35.32.130, by reason of the facts above stated and the emergency which is hereby declared to exist, this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon the approval or the signing of the same by the Mayor, or passage over his veto as provided by the Charter of the City of Seattle.







