ORDINANCE 187500

AN ORDINANCE relating to and authorizing construction of watermains and sewers in connection with the new 1st Avenue South Bridge and making appropriations from the Water Fund and the Sewer Fund therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Board of Public Works is hereby authorized and directed to prepare plans and specifications for the construction of the necessary watermains and sewers in the streets within the City intersecting West Marginal Way in the vicinity of the new 1st Avenue South Bridge at an estimated cost of \$18,000.00 for watermains and \$30,000.00 for sewers, as contemplated by C. F. 229453. Said construction shall be accomplished by the letting of a contract or contracts therefor, or the same or any part thereof may be accomplished by day labor in the discretion of the Board of Public Works.

Section 2. That in order to effectuate said purpose the sum of Eighteen Thousand Dollars (\$18,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated from the Water Fund and the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated from the Sewer Fund as betterment outlays and the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants therefor.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
