by readvertising. The Board of Public Works wishes to award the contract as soon as possible in order to have the work completed before the buildup of student traffic when the University re-

opens in the fall. In order to award the contract, the appropriation must be increased by \$25,000 to \$202,000.

We respectfully recommend that this council bill be approved.
