AN ORDINANCE providing for the acquisition by condemnation of certain property in Block 21, Gilman's Addition, for extension of the present garbage disposal site.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That public necessity requires that the following described real property situated in Seattle, King County, Washington, to-wit:

Block 21, Gilman's Addition to the City of Seattle, together with all rights, privileges and other property pertaining thereto, be and the same are hereby condemned, appropriated and taken for public use, to-wit: The extension of the present garbage disposal site exclusive of any use of such extension for the burning of trash, said property to be so appropriated and taken only after just compensation has been made and paid into court for the owners thereof in the manner provided by law.

Section 2. That the entire cost of such acquisition shall be paid from such fund as may be provided by ordinance.

Section 3. That the Corporation Counsel is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings, in the manner provided by law, necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

AN ORDINANCE providing for the acquisition by condemnation of certain property in Block 21, Gilman's Addition, for extension of the present garbage disposal site.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That public necessity requires that the following described real property situated in Seattle, King County, Washington, to-wit:

Block 21, Gilman's Addition to the City of Seattle,

together with all rights, privileges and other property pertaining thereto, be and the same are hereby condemned, appropriated and taken for public use, to-wit: The extension of the present garbage disposal site exclusive of any use of such extension for the burning of trash, said property to be so appropriated and taken only after just compensation has been made and paid into court for the owners thereof in the manner provided by law.

Section 2. That the entire cost of such acquisition shall be paid from such fund as may be provided by ordinance.

Section 3. That the Corporation Counsel is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings, in the manner provided by law, necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
