ORDINANCE 85785

AN ORDINANCE accepting the condemnation awards for the widening of Mineral Springs Way between Ashworth Avenue and Meridian Avenue under Ordinance 84990, King County Cause No. 497109, and making an appropriation from the City Street Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the condemnation awards set forth in the verdicts of the jury entered December 3, 1950, and to be included in the Judgment in the matter of the petition of the City of Seattle to take and damage land necessary for the laying off, opening, widening, extending and establishing of Mineral Springs Way between Ashworth Avenue and Meridian Avenue, as contemplated by Ordinance 84990, King County Superior Court Cause No. 497109, are hereby accepted.

Section 2. For the payment of such award, interest and costs, there is hereby appropriated from the City Street Fund Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, and the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to pay the necessary monies into court by warrant, and the City Treasurer is authorized to pay the same.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
