The City of Seattle does ordain as follows

Section 1

That the Mayor and Clerk of the City of Seattle be and they are hereby directed authorized and empowered to make and execute for and in the name of said City a contract with said firm W.S. Matt & Co for the purchase of a Hook and Ladder Truck in accordance with said proposal bid and specifications for the sum of Two thousand and seven hundred and Eighty eight Dollars (\$2788⁰⁰)

Section 2

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval

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Ordinance 858[#]

An ordinance to further extend establish lay out and open Natches Street in the City of Seattle.

The City of Seattle does ordain as follows

Section 1

That Natches Street in the City of Seattle be and the same is hereby extended opened and established as a public Street highway and avenue sixty (60) feet wide, as follows: Commencing at

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the Northeast corner of Block four (4) in Laws first Addition to the City of Seattle thence running in a Northerly direction on the line of Natches Street produced to the Portage County Road thence in Northeasterly direction to the North and South one eighth line of the South west one quarter of Section twenty eight (28) Township twenty five (25) North of range four (4) East thence in a Southerly direction on said one eighth produced to Madison Street in said City thence in a south westerly direction along the Northerly side of said Madison Street to a point in line with the west side of of said Natches Street produced thence North to the place of beginning

Section 2

That so much of Private property as is embraced within the limits and boundaries of said Natches Street as open extended and established by Section 1 of this ordinance be and the same hereby is condemned and appropriated to the public use of the City of Seattle as a Street and public highway due compensation to be made therefor as provided by law and the amount of said compensation is hereby made a charge upon the lots and parcels of land fronting and abutting upon said Natches Street as hereby extended laid out and established

Section 3

That the City Surveyor shall as soon as practicable make a plat of the land appropriated for the extension and opening of said Natches Street by this ordinance and the land within the assessment district created and described by section 4 of this ordinance and file the same in the office of the City Clerk - said plat to show the lines of said Street as extended and established by this ordinance and of

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each smallest subdivision of land within said district -
Section 4

That an assessment district be and is hereby created comprising and including all lands subject to taxation for general municipal purposes situated within one hundred and twenty eight (128) feet on each side of said Natches Street between the termini of the same as extended and established by this ordinance to wit: between the Portage County road and Madison St. in said city of Seattle. And the whole cost of the proceedings for the extension and opening of said Natches street as aforesaid including payment to be made to the owners of lands appropriated, as compensation therefor is hereby levied and made a charge upon the lands subject to taxation for general municipal purposes within said assessment district.

Section 5

That an assessment of said lands within said district for the purpose specified in the preceding section and an appraisement of the lands appropriated by this ordinance shall be made by three (3) assessors who shall be appointed in the manner prescribed in Section 101 of the Charter of the City of Seattle and a notice to appoint said assessors shall be given in the following manner, to wit: The City Clerk shall as soon as this ordinance takes effect issue and sign a notice to the owners of the lands appropriated by this ordinance to appoint one of said assessors and a similar notice to the owners of the lands within said assessment district to appoint one of said assessors and cause each of said notices to be published for five consecutive days in the official newspaper of the City of Seattle and each of said notices shall specify the time within which said appointments shall be made and shall require said

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appointments to be made in writing and filed with the City Clerk.

Section 6

That the assessment of land in said district shall be made according to value and as soon as practicable after the whole amount necessary to be raised by said assessment shall have been ascertained the Common Council shall by order fix the rate of assessment and the City Clerk shall prepare an assessment roll and list thereon each parcel of land in said district showing the amount thereof as fixed by the assessors and the amount of the assessment thereon at the rate fixed by the Common Council and shall certify the same as other assessment rolls to the City Treasurer who shall at once publish a notice for five days in the official newspaper of the City to all persons claiming any interest in said lands to pay the assessment thereon within forty (40) days from the day of the first publication of said notice. All the assessments not paid within the time specified in said notice shall be delinquent and shall be collected by suit in the name of the City and foreclosure of the lien upon said lands.

Section 7

That all assessments becoming delinquent shall bear interest at the rate of ten per cent per annum from the time of becoming delinquent.

Section 8

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
