ORDINANCE 86042

AN ORDINANCE relating to the acquisition by condemnation of land and other property in Block 5, Sturtevant's Rainier Beach Villa Tracts, for playground purposes and providing for payment by assessment upon the property specially benefited.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That public necessity and convenience require that the following described property, to-wit:

Block 5, Sturtevant's Rainier Beach Villa Tracts, as recorded in Vol. 16 of Plats, page 32, Records of King County, Washington, together with all rights, privileges and other property pertaining thereto be and the same are hereby condemned, appropriated and taken for a public use, namely, for playground purposes, said lands, rights, privileges and other property to be so appropriated and taken only after just compensation has been made or paid into court for the owners thereof in the manner provided by law.

Section 2. That the cost of such acquisition shall be paid for by assessment upon property specially benefited in the manner provided by law.

Section 3. That the Corporation Counsel is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings, in the manner provided by law necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That public necessity and convenience require that the following described property, to-wit:

Block 5, Sturtevant's Rainier Beach Villa Tracts, as recorded in Vol. 10 of Plat, page 32, Records of King County, Washington,

together with all rights, privileges and other property pertaining thereto, be and the same are hereby condemned, appropriated and taken for a public use, namely, for playground purposes, said lands, rights, privileges and other property to be so appropriated and taken only after just compensation has been made or paid into Court for the owners thereof in the manner provided by law.

Section 2. That the cost of such acquisition shall be paid for by assessment upon property specially benefited in the manner provided by law.

Section 3. That the Corporation Counsel is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings in the manner provided by law necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
