BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 3. That in the reasonable original grading of the pipe line roadways as described in Section 2 of this ordinance, the City shall acquire the right, in the case of a cut, to remove the lateral support of the property abutting on said roadways, and in every case the right to remove said lateral support shall include the right to carry the slopes back into and extending upon the abutting real property for at least one foot for each foot of depth of cut, and in the case of a fill, the right shall be acquired to extend and maintain upon the abutting real property slopes of one and one-half feet for each foot of elevation of fill for the purpose of acquiring lateral support for said roadways; reserving unto the abutting property owners respectively the right at any time to remove said lateral support upon providing and maintaining other adequate lateral support for said roadways.

Section 4. That the Corporation Counsel be and he is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings in the manner provided by law to condemn, take, damage and appropriate the lands and other property, property rights and privileges necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 5. That such acquisition is hereby declared to be a part of the additions and betterments to and extensions of the existing Municipal Water Works Plant and System of the City of Seattle provided for by Ordinance No. 85642, and the cost of such acquisition shall be paid from the funds provided by said Ordinance No. 85642.

Section 6. That in conducting said condemnation proceedings, the Corporation Counsel is hereby authorized to enter into stipulations for the purpose of minimizing damages.

Section ... 7... This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval. if approved by the Mayor: otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

The attached Council Bill provides for the acquisition by condemnation of property and property rights for the Tolt River Pipe Line. This bill provides for the taking of all needed property between the impounding reservoir on the property between the impounding reservoir on the south fork of the Tolt River to the existing Lake Forest Park Reservoir, with the exception of property owned by the Weyerhaeuser Timber Company and the State of Washington east of the Swan County Road. Negotiations are now in progress to see the Road. Negotistions are now in progress to acquire the necessary property rights from these owners.

This Council Bill has been approved as to form by the Corporation Counsel.
