ORDINANCE NO. 23334

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Engineering Department; authorizing the acquisition of certain property in Block 6, Terry's 5th Addition, and in Block 7, Plummer's Addition, for the enlargement of shop and maintenance headquarters; making a reimbursable appropriation from the Emergency Fund and declaring the emergency therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Engineer is hereby authorized, for and on behalf of the City of Seattle, to acquire by purchase from the owners thereof, the following described real property, to-wit:

1. East one-half of Lot 1 and east one-half of the south 10 feet of Lot 2, Block 6, Terry's 5th Addition to the City of Seattle, as recorded in Volume 2 of Plats, page 55, records of King County;
2. Lot 1, Block 7, Plummer's Addition to the City of Seattle as recorded in Volume 1 of Plats, page 133, records of King County;

for the total sum, including certain costs, of Seven Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$7,250.00), which sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the Emergency Fund to be reimbursable by appropriation of a like sum which is hereby made from the City Street Fund, and upon receipt of good and sufficient conveyance of said property the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants therefor. That the acquisition of said property is necessary for the enlargement of the Charles Street Shop and Maintenance Headquarters of the Engineering Department, as requested in C. F. 233334.

Section 2. WHEREAS, the appropriation from the Emergency Fund in Section 1 hereof is to meet actual necessary expenses of the Engineering Department for which no appropriation has been made due to causes which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of making the 1957 Budget of said department; Now, Therefore, in

accordance with RCW 35.32.130 by reason of the facts above stated and the emergency which is hereby declared to exist this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon the approval or signing of the same by the Mayor or passage over his veto as provided by the Charter of the city.

PASSED by unanimous vote of the City Council the 12 day of November, 1957, and signed by me in open session in authentication of its passage this 12 day of November, 1957.
