BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That public necessity and convenience demand that West Barton Street in the vicinity of Fauntleroy Avenue be, and the same is hereby laid off, opened, widened, extended and established over and across the following described property, situate in King County, Washington, to-wit:

That portion of Government Lot 2 in Section 35, Township 24 North, Range 3 East, W.M., bounded on the west by the Meander Line; on the east by the west line of Fauntleroy Avenue; on the south by the north line of West Barton Street (as established by deed accepted by Ordinance 33066); and bounded on the north by a line paralleling the north line of said Government Lot 2 and extending west to the Meander Line from a point on said west line of Fauntleroy Avenue 500 feet southerly, measured along said west line, from the north line of said Government Lot 2; together with the tide lands of the second class abutting thereon above the line of mean low tide.

Section 2. That all lands, rights, privileges and other property lying within the limits of the tract of land described in Section 1 hereof are hereby condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged for the purpose of a public street and highway, and said lands, rights, privileges and other property are to be taken, damaged, and appropriated only after just compensation has been made or paid into court for the owners thereof in the manner provided by law.

Section 3. That the entire cost of the improvement provided for herein shall be paid from the City Street Fund.

Section 4. That the Corporation Counsel be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings in the manner provided by law, to condemn, take, damage and appropriate the lands and other property necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.
