BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That public necessity requires the following described property situated in King County, Washington, to-wit:

IN LAKEWOOD ADDITION, A REPLAT OF PART OF MAYNARD'S LAKE WASHINGTON ADDITION, (recorded in Volume 10 of King County Plats, at Page 46.)

Section 2. That the Corporation Counsel is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings in the manner provided by law, necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That public necessity requires the following described property, situated in King County, Washington, to-wit:
