ORDINANCE 238320

AN ORDINANCE authorizing an agreement with the State of Washington for reimbursement to the city of its costs incurred in connection with the removal and relocation of a certain watermain and appurtenances necessitated by the construction of Primary State Highway No. 1, Seattle Freeway, from East Prospect Street to Shelby Street, authorizing such removal and relocation, and making a reimbursable appropriation from the Water Fund therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Comptroller are hereby authorized to execute and deliver for and on behalf of the City of Seattle an agreement with the State of Washington, State Highway Commission, which agreement shall be substantially in the form attached to C. F. 238320, with attached Exhibits, "A" Specifications, "B" Estimates, "C" Drawings, providing for reimbursement to the city of its costs incurred in connection with the removal and relocation of a 20-inch watermain and appurtenances located in Boylston Avenue North between East Lynn Street and a point approximately 350 feet north of Roanoke Street, necessitated by the construction of Primary State Highway No. 1, Seattle Freeway, from East Prospect Street to Shelby Street, as recommended by the City Engineer in C. F. 238320.

Section 2. That the City Engineer is authorized to prepare plans and specifications for and under the direction of the Board of Public Works proceed with the removal and relocation of said watermain and appurtenances, as recommended by the City Engineer in C. F. 238320, which removal and relocation shall be accomplished by the awarding of a contract or contracts therefor or the same may be accomplished by day labor in the discretion of the Board of Public Works.

Section 3. That any action taken hereunder prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. That in order to effectuate such purpose, the sum of Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the Water Fund as an emergency outlay, reimbursable from the State in the full amount expended,

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

in accordance with the agreement hereinabove referred to, and the City Comptroller is authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
