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ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE establishing, modifying and abrogating certain positions in the Police, Engineering, Water, Executive, Health, Park, Lighting, Law, Civil Service and Building Departments and in the office of the Employees' Retirement System and the Municipal Court; fixing compensations; superseding the 1961 Salary Ordinance (89800) insofar as in conflict and providing funds by appropriation, budget item transfers and a partially reimbursable appropriation from the Emergency Fund and declaring the emergency therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 2. That the respective department heads are hereby authorized to fill the positions herein established, subject to Civil Service laws and rules, and to use unexpended budget salary funds accumulating in the 1961 Budgets of their respective departments to pay the salaries of the additional positions herein established or modified, and the necessary budget item transfers are hereby made.

Section 3. That in order to pay the compensation of the new positions herein established in the Engineering, Park and Health Departments and in the offices of the Employees' Retirement System and of the Municipal Court, the sums of \$17,256.00, \$6,492.00, \$6,480.00, \$6,000.00 and \$7,284.00, respectively, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated from the Emergency Fund, said fund to be partially reimbursed by transfers which are hereby made of like sums from the unexpended budget salary funds accumulating in the 1961 Budgets of the Engineering Department (Reimbursable Section), Park Department, Seattle-King County Public Health Department (Reimbursable Section) and by appropriation, which is hereby made, from the Employees' Retirement Fund.

Section 4. That the 1961 Salary Ordinance (89800) insofar as in conflict herewith is hereby superseded.

Section 5. WHEREAS, the appropriations from the Emergency Fund in Section 3 hereof are to meet actual necessary expenditures of the various departments of the city for which no appropriations have been made due to causes which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of making the 1961 Budget; Now, Therefore, in accordance with RCW 35.32.130 by reason of the facts hereinabove set forth and the emergency which is hereby declared to exist, this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon the approval or signing of the same by the Mayor or passage over his veto as provided by the Charter of the city.


RECOMMEND that the same be amended as follows: in the title insert a coma after "Law"; delete "and" following "Law"; insert a coma after "Civil Service"; add "and Building" immediately after "Civil Service".

Under "ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT (REIMBURSABLE SECTION):" delete fourth and fifth lines "1 Auto . . . and Warehouses".

Under "EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT (MOTOR TRANSPORTATION FUND):" line 5 change "3" to "4" "Auto . . . Foreman"; delete line 6 "1 Auto . . . \$612 mo."

Following line two under "CIVIL SERVICE DEPARTMENT:" add "BUILDING DEPARTMENT:" and under "BUILDING DEPARTMENT:" the following "1 Chief Boiler Inspector (Incumbent) at a salary of \$670 mo. in lieu of 1 Associate Engineer - Mechanical", and that when so amended THE SAME DO PASS.
