ORDINANCE 50680

AN ORDINANCE authorizing an agreement with the State of Washington for the construction, removal and relocation of certain water facilities necessitated by the construction of Primary State Highway No. 1, Seattle Freeway, from East Republican Street to East Prospect Street, authorizing such construction, removal and relocation, and making a partially reimbursable appropriation from the Water Fund therefor, subject to the protest in Resolution 18984.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and the City Comptroller are hereby authorized to execute and deliver for and on behalf of The City of Seattle an agreement with the State of Washington, State Highway Commission, substantially in the form identified as GC 1036, HWY 1, 1792, Control Section and attached to C. F. 243725 with attached exhibits, "A" Specifications, "B" Estimates, "C" Plans, providing for the construction, removal and relocation of certain water facilities, necessitated by the construction of Primary State Highway No. 1, Seattle Freeway, from East Republican Street to East Prospect Street, as recommended by the City Engineer in C. F. 243725.

Section 2. That any act pursuant to the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance, is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. That the City Engineer is authorized to prepare plans and specifications for, and under the direction of the Board of Public Works proceed with the construction, removal and relocation of certain Water Department facilities in Bellevue Avenue East, as recommended by the City Engineer in C. F. 243725, and as more specifically set forth in said agreement, which construction, removal and relocation shall be accomplished by the awarding of a contract or contracts therefor or the same may be accomplished by day labor in the discretion of the Board of Public Works.

Section 4. That in order to effectuate such purpose, the sum of One Hundred Thirty-five Thousand Dollars (\$135,000), or so much

thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the Water Fund as an emergency and betterment outlay, partially reimbursable from the State in accordance with the agreement herein authorized, and the City Comptroller is authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants.

Section 5. Execution and delivery of such agreement and credit for extended service life as herein authorized shall not be construed as a waiver of the city's protest under Resolution 18984 against implementation of the United States Department of Commerce, Bureau of Public Roads Instructional Memorandum 30-3-61 requiring certain extended service life credits and payments in connection with relocations and replacements of city utilities to accommodate federally assisted State highway construction, and the City Engineer shall endorse on such agreement prior to execution and delivery the following:

"Execution, delivery and performance of this agreement by and on behalf of The City of Seattle is not a waiver of the City's protest expressed in Resolution 18984 objecting to payments or credits by the City for 'extended service life'".

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
