ORDINANCE 90853

AN ORDINANCE authorizing an agreement with the State of Washington for the construction by the City of certain water facilities necessitated by the construction of Primary State Highway No. 1, Roanoke Connection, from 10th Avenue East to Montlake Boulevard, authorizing such construction and making a reimbursable appropriation from the Water Fund therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and the City Comptroller are hereby authorized to execute and deliver for and on behalf of The City of Seattle an agreement with the State of Washington, State Highway Commission, substantially in the form attached to C. F. 244246 with attached exhibits, "A" Specifications, "B" Estimate of Cost, "C" Plans, providing for the construction by the City of certain water facilities, necessitated by the construction of Primary State Highway No. 1, Roanoke Connection, from 10th Avenue East to Montlake Boulevard, and for payment of the cost thereof by the State as recommended by the City Engineer and Mayor in C. F. 244246.

Section 2. That any act pursuant to the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance, is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. That the City Engineer is authorized to prepare plans and specifications for, and under the direction of the Board of Public Works proceed with the construction of an 8-inch cast iron pipe watermain in East Miller Street between 10th Avenue East and 11th Avenue East and in Everett Avenue East from Delmar Drive East to Boyer Avenue East, as contemplated in C. F. 244246, which construction, shall be accomplished by the awarding of a contract or contracts therefor or the same may be accomplished by day labor in the discretion of the Board of Public Works.

Section 4. That for such watermain construction, the sum of Thirteen Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$13,200), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the Water Fund as an

emergency outlay, reimbursable from the State in accordance with the agreement herein authorized, and the City Comptroller is authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
