ORDINANCE 91912

AN ORDINANCE providing for the acquisition by condemnation of land and other property in Block 8, Burke's First Addition and Block 45, Lake Union Shorelands, for park, recreation and harbor patrol purposes.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That public convenience and necessity demand that the following described property, to-wit:

Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4, Block 8, Burke's First Addition to the City of Seattle and Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4, Block 45, Lake Union Shorelands,

together with all rights, privileges and other property pertaining thereto be and the same are hereby condemned and appropriated and taken for a public use, namely, for park, recreation and harbor patrol purposes.

Section 2. Said lands, rights, privileges and other property are to be so appropriated and taken only after just compensation has been made or paid into court for the owners thereof in the manner provided by law.

Section 3. That the entire cost of the acquisition provided for in this ordinance shall be paid from the Seattle Park Improvement Bonds 1960 Fund, or from such other funds as may be provided by ordinance.

Section 4. That the Corporation Counsel is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute proceedings in the manner provided by law to condemn, take, damage and appropriate the lands and other property necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance, and to stipulate for the purpose of minimizing damages.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
