ORDINANCE 92301

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Engineering Department; providing for the construction of certain walkways and a stairway, and grading and installation of surface drainage in portions of Southwest Graham Street and the approximate extension west thereof between Delridge Way Southwest and High Point Drive Southwest; authorizing the acquisition of certain property and making an appropriation from the City Street Fund therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Engineer is authorized to acquire the necessary property and prepare plans and specifications for and under the direction of the Board of Public Works proceed with the improvement of Southwest Graham Street and the approximate extension west thereof between Delridge Way Southwest and High Point Drive Southwest by construction of certain walkways and a stairway, and by grading and installing surface drainage where necessary, which improvement may be effected by the awarding of contract or contracts, by day labor, or by both in the discretion of said Board, all as recommended by the City Engineer in C. F. 248473.

Section 2. That to effectuate Section 1 hereof, there is hereby appropriated the sum of Thirty Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000) from the City Street Fund, and the City Comptroller is authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
