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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the offer of the United States of America to The City of Seattle, designated "Contract for Planning Advance", consisting of Parts I and II, and contained in C. F. 249668, under and subject to the provisions, terms and conditions of which the United States of America would make an advance of federal funds to The City of Seattle to aid in financing the cost of certain surveys and plans for the proposed South Seattle Redevelopment Project situated in the City of Seattle, Washington and described in and authorized by Ordinance 90744 is hereby in all respects accepted, and the undertaking of surveys and plans for an urban renewal redevelopment project in said area, declared a "blighted area" and appropriate for an urban renewal redevelopment project by said ordinance is hereby approved; and in witness whereof the Mayor and City Comptroller are authorized to execute for and on behalf of the City such contract in duplicate originals substantially in the form contemplated in said Comptroller's file.

Section 2. That the City hereby agrees to abide by all the provisions, terms and conditions of said contract.

Section 3. That the City Council is cognizant of the conditions imposed in the undertaking and carrying out of urban renewal projects with Federal financial assistance under Title I of the Housing Act of 1949, including those prohibiting discrimination because of race, color, creed or national origin.

Section 4. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed forthwith to send to the Housing and Home Finance Agency two

certified copies of the proceedings of the City in connection with the adoption of this ordinance together with two certified copies of this ordinance and such further documents or proofs in connection with the acceptance of said offer as may be required by the Federal Government.

Section 5. That the Mayor of The City of Seattle is hereby authorized to file requisitions together with the necessary supporting documents with the United States of America from time to time as advance funds are required, requesting payments to be made to the City on account of the advance provided for in said offer, and to do and perform all other things and acts required to be done or performed in order to obtain such payments.

Section 6. Any action taken pursuant to this ordinance prior to the effective date hereof is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
