AN ORDINANCE amending Section 23 of Ordinance 16046 to delete from the activities declared thereby to be unlawful, "the casting of horoscopes."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

*Ord 102458* Section 1. That Section 23 of Ordinance 16046 as last amended by Ordinance 90712 be further amended to read as follows:

Section 23. It is unlawful for anyone to engage in gambling, bunco or swindling games or to operate or possess any device for swindling or defrauding others, or to engage in the telling of fortunes or the reading of palms for compensation, gratuity or reward.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

AN ORDINANCE amending Section 23 of Ordinance 16046 to delete from the activities declared thereby to be unlawful, "the casting of horoscopes."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 23 of Ordinance 16046 as last amended by Ordinance 90712 be further amended to read as follows:

Section 23. It is unlawful for anyone to engage in gambling, bunco or swindling games or to operate or possess any device for swindling or defrauding others, or to engage in the telling of fortunes or the reading of palms for compensation, gratuity or reward.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
