AN ORDINANCE creating the Seattle Center Department for the administration, management, and control of the Seattle Center, parking garage and Monorail system pursuant to Chapter 132, Laws of 1965; providing for appointment of a Director to supervise said department and defining his duties.

WHEREAS, The City of Seattle has under Ordinance 93769 continued on a temporary basis the functions and services previously performed by Century 21 Center, Inc. in connection with the Seattle Center and Monorail system pending establishment of a separate department of municipal government for such purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor recommends (C. F. 254562) that a Seattle Center Department be established pursuant to Chapter 132, Laws of 1965; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That as of January 1, 1966 there shall be a Seattle Center Department for the administration, management, control and maintenance of Seattle Center properties, facilities and programs and the Seattle Parking Garage and the Monorail System.

There shall be a director of said department to be appointed by the Mayor, subject to confirmation by a majority vote of all members of the City Council, and such director, whose office shall not be included in the classified civil service, may be removed by the Mayor upon filing a statement of his reasons therefor with the City Council.

The Director shall be the head of the Seattle Center Department and shall on behalf of the City enter into such contracts, leases, concessions and other agreements as are authorized by ordinance and are related to the Seattle Center, Seattle Parking Garage and the Monorail System. The Director shall appoint and remove, subject to applicable civil service provisions, and supervise and control all officers and employees in his department; shall advertise events and publicize and otherwise promote the use of Seattle Center facilities; shall seek to obtain reasonable revenue from the use of properties under his jurisdiction; shall keep a current inventory of all property under his jurisdiction; and shall, through the Mayor, make a quarterly report to the City Council of the revenues and expenses

related to the administration and operation of the Seattle Center, the Seattle Center Parking Garage and the Monorail System. The Director shall be responsible to the Mayor for the administration of said department.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

WHEREAS, The City of Seattle has under Ordinance 93769 constituted on a temporary basis the functions and services presently performed by Century 21 Center, Inc. in connection with the Seattle Center and Memorial system pending re-establishment of a separate department of municipal government for such purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor recommends (C. 94446) that a Seattle Center Department be established pursuant to Chapter 12, Laws of 1965; Now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That as of January 1, 1966 there shall be a Seattle Center Department for the administration, management, control and maintenance of Seattle Center, parking, average and Memorial system and the Seattle Center Garage and the Memorial System. There shall be a director of said department to be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the City Council and such director shall have such powers and duties as shall be included in the classification of said position as determined by the Mayor upon filing a statement of his intent thereto with the City Council.

The Director shall be the head of the Seattle Center Department and shall, on behalf of the City, control, manage, maintain, operate and administer the Seattle Center, parking, average and Memorial system, the Seattle Center Garage and the Memorial System. The Director shall receive, collect and disburse all moneys and revenues and shall be responsible for the operation and maintenance of the Seattle Center, parking, average and Memorial system, the Seattle Center Garage and the Memorial System. The Director shall also be responsible for the operation and maintenance of the Seattle Center, parking, average and Memorial system, the Seattle Center Garage and the Memorial System. Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, and shall become effective at the time it shall become a law of the City of Seattle.
