ORDINANCE 94655

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Engineering Department; providing for construction of Traffic Engineering shops at the Charles Street Service Center and making an appropriation from the City Street Fund therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Superintendent of Buildings under the direction of the Board of Public Works is hereby authorized to proceed with the construction of Traffic Engineering shops at the Charles Street Service Center, in accordance with plans and specifications prepared therefor, to be effected by the awarding of a contract or contracts therefor or by day labor in the discretion of said Board, and for such purpose and related costs contemplated by the City Engineer in C. F. 255210, the sum of Four Hundred Seventy Five Thousand Dollars (\$475,000) or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated from the City Street Fund, and the City Comptroller is authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
