ORDINANCE 94656

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Engineering Department; authorizing the preparation of plans, specifications and cost estimates for landscaping Fortson Square and abutting Second Avenue South, making an appropriation from the Emergency Fund and declaring the emergency therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to prepare plans, specifications and cost estimates for the improvement by landscaping of Fortson Square and abutting Second Avenue South, and to accomplish such purpose the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated from the Emergency Fund, as requested by the City Engineer in C. F. 254168, and the City Comptroller is authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrant.

Section 2. WHEREAS, the appropriation from the Emergency Fund herein made is to meet actual necessary expenditures of the Engineering Department for which no appropriation has been made due to causes which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of making the 1966 Budget of said department; Now, Therefore, in accordance with RCW 35.32.130 by reason of the facts hereinabove set forth and the emergency which is hereby declared to exist, this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon the approval or signing of the same by the Mayor or passage over his veto as provided by the Charter of the City.

PASSED by unanimous vote of the City Council the 28 day of March, 1966, and signed by me in open session in authentication of its passage this 28 day of March, 1966.
