ORDINANCE 95966

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Sewerage Utility; authorizing construction of Boeing Sewage Pumping Station No. 2 on Boeing Field adjacent to Airport Way South and making an appropriation from the Sewer Fund therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Engineer in accordance with plans and specifications prepared by him is authorized to proceed under the direction of the Board of Public Works with the construction of Boeing Sewage Pumping Station No. 2 on Boeing Field adjacent to Airport Way South approximately 200 feet south of the westerly extension of South Webster Street as recommended by the City Engineer in C. F. 258516. Said improvement may be effected by the awarding of a contract or contracts therefor, or the same or any part thereof may be effected by day labor in the discretion of said Board.

Section 2. That in order to effectuate Section 1 hereof, the sum of Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated from the Sewer Fund and the City Comptroller is authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
