ORDINANCE 96152

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Engineering Department; authorizing the landscaping of Fortson Square and abutting Second Avenue South; making an appropriation from the Emergency Fund and declaring the emergency therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Engineer is hereby authorized to proceed under the direction of the Board of Public Works with the improvement by landscaping of Fortson Square and abutting Second Avenue South as contemplated by C.F. 254168 and in accordance with plans and specifications prepared pursuant to Ordinance 94656. Said improvement may be effected by the awarding of a contract or contracts therefor or the same or any part thereof may be effected by day labor in the discretion of said Board. To accomplish such purpose the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated from the Emergency Fund, as requested by the City Engineer in C.F. 259197, and the City Comptroller is authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants.

Section 2. WHEREAS, the appropriation from the Emergency Fund herein made is to meet actual necessary expenditures of the City for which no appropriation has been made due to causes which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of making the 1967 Budget; Now, Therefore, in accordance with Ch. 7, Section 8,

Laws of Washington 1967, Regular Session, by reason of the facts above stated and the emergency which is hereby declared to exist, this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon the approval or signing of the same by the Mayor or passage over his veto, as provided by the Charter of the City.

PASSED by three-fourths vote of all the members of the City Council the 9 day of October, 1967, and signed by me in open session in authentication of its passage this 9 day of October, 1967.
