ORDINANCE 1030

AN ORDINANCE designating an unnamed road in the University of Washington Arboretum as East Foster Island Road.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the unnamed road which begins at Lake Washington Boulevard East in the vicinity of East McGraw Street and extends in a generally easterly direction for approximately 800 feet to an intersection with Arboretum Drive East and approximately 500 feet further in a generally northeasterly direction to a dead end, is hereby designated as East Foster Island Road as recommended in C. F. 260452.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
