ORDINANCE 96839

SEATTLE CITY COUNCIL

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Seattle Model City Program and authorizing expenditures from the Model City Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That expenditures from the Model City Fund for Model City purposes described by ordinance or by contracts with the Federal Government are hereby authorized, the necessary appropriations and transfers are hereby made, and the City Comptroller is authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants upon vouchers approved by the Mayor or his Administrative Assistant, provided vouchers for amounts of less than \$25.00 may be approved by the Model City Director.

Section 2. Any act pursuant to and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
