ORDINANCE 98956

AN ORDINANCE providing that the hospital, care and nursing benefits provided for active or retired firemen under the provisions of RCW 41.26.150 shall be paid from the Firemen's Pension Fund established pursuant to RCW 41.16.050.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That as of March 1, 1970, as requested in C.F. 266421 and as authorized by RCW 41.26.150(1), all hospital, care and nursing benefits provided for active or retired firemen under the provisions of RCW 41.26.150 shall be paid from the Firemen's Pension Fund established pursuant to RCW 41.16.050.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
