ORDINANCE 99236

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Engineering Department; authorizing preparation of plans, specifications and estimates in connection with the placement of street lighting and traffic signal facilities underground and making an appropriation from the Arterial Development fund therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Engineer is authorized to prepare plans, specifications and estimates for the placement of street lighting and traffic signal facilities underground in the following streets:

Rainier Avenue South from South Lake Way to Empire Way South.

23rd Avenue East and 23rd Avenue from East Aloha Street to South Lake Way.

Aurora Avenue North from Denny Way to south abutment of George Washington Memorial Bridge (Aurora Bridge).

Golf Drive South from 12th Avenue South to 15th Avenue South and South Norman Street.

15th Avenue South from South Norman Street to South Judkins Street.

14th Avenue South from South Judkins Street to Beacon Avenue South.

Beacon Avenue South from 14th Avenue South to South Barton Street.

as contemplated in King County Resolution 3456 and C.F. 267492 and for such purpose the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated from the Arterial Development Fund.

Section 2. That any act pursuant to the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 3 . This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
