ORDINANCE 99545

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Engineering Department, authorizing the acquisition of property and property rights necessary for the Bay Freeway; making a reimbursable appropriation from the Arterial City Street Fund for such purpose, and the related expenses of the Engineering and Law Departments in such connection.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That, as requested in C.F. 267895, the City Engineer is authorized to obtain appraisals and other expert and consultant services in connection therewith and thereafter for and on behalf of the City to negotiate for and purchase at a total consideration not to exceed Five Million Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$5,900,000) such right of way as may be necessary for the construction of the Bay Freeway consistent with findings contained in C.F. 268017 adopted by Ordinance 99397, and for such purposes and for appraisal costs, title insurance, escrow fees, closing costs, and any real estate taxes for which the City is by statute required to reimburse the seller and the expenses of the Law and Engineering Departments in connection with such acquisition by purchase or by subsequent condemnation the sum of Six Million Dollars (\$6,000,000) or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated from the Arterial City Street Fund, reimbursable as to the cost of the entire project contemplated by said Ordinance 99397 from the Urban Arterial Trust Account to the extent of approximately ninety percent (90%) of such appropriation and reimbursable by an appropriation hereby made of Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000) from the

Seattle General Improvement Bonds 1960 Fund for that portion of the total land acquisition costs herein authorized specifically and functionally related to a connection for traffic in the vicinity of Mercer or Valley Streets to connect Interstate 5, Seattle Freeway and Aurora Avenue North, and the City Engineer shall adopt such accounting procedures as shall maintain such segregation of costs, which segregation shall also be applicable to Law and Engineering Department expense, and the City Comptroller is authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants and make the necessary transfers.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
