ORDINANCE 99911

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Superintendent of Parks and Recreation to designate the names for park and recreation facilities and establishing a Parks and Recreation Naming Committee in connection therewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That as recommended in C. F. 269124 the Superintendent of Parks and Recreation is hereby authorized to designate the names of parks, recreation areas or facilities from among names submitted to him by a Parks and Recreation Naming Committee hereby created which shall consist of the Superintendent of Parks and Recreation, the Chairman of the Board of Park Commissioners, and the Chairman of the Parks and Public Grounds Committee of the City Council, and said naming committee is authorized to establish policies and procedures as contemplated in said C. F. to be followed in selecting names to be submitted to the Superintendent.

Upon designating a name for a park, recreation area or facility the Superintendent of Parks and Recreation shall submit such name to the Mayor, and Chairman of the Parks and Public Grounds Committee of the City Council, and if no objection to such name is made by the Mayor or said Chairman within ten days of such submittal, and upon filing of such name designation in the office of the City Comptroller, the name shall thereupon become officially adopted.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 2... This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

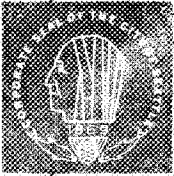
