

RESOLUTION NO. 14456

A RESOLUTION designating Seattle as "The City of Flowers" and adopting such designation as the official slogan of the City.

WHEREAS, the soil and climatic conditions in Seattle are especially favorable for flowers, which are cultivated by our citizens and bloom in endless variety, profusion and perfection throughout the year, so that Seattle may well be designated "The City of Flowers", which designation should be adopted as the official descriptive slogan; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATTLE:

That the designation "The City of Flowers" is hereby adopted as the official descriptive slogan of the City of Seattle; and our citizens are requested and urged to further plant and cultivate the various types and varieties of flowers and further beautify the City; and to use such slogan as best descriptive of the City.

PASSED the City Council the 7 day of October, 1946, and signed by me in open session in authentication of its passage this 7 day of October, 1946.


