A Resolution authorizing and directing the Board of Public Works to enter into an agreement with Alaska-Yukon-Pacific Exposition, a corporation, for the use by said Corporation of certain water pipe, hydrants and fittings belonging to The City of Seattle.

W H E R E A S, on the 6th day of April, 1908, Alaska-Yukon Pacific Exposition, a corporation, by and through its committee on Buildings and Grounds, petitioned the City Council of The City of Seattle that said City loan to said Corporation certain water pipe, hydrants and fittings, the property of The City of Seattle, during its exposition in 1909; and

W H E R E A S, said petition was referred to the Fire and Water committee of the City Council, which committee, in its report thereon to the City Council, recommended that said petition, in part, be granted (said petition and the committee's report thereon being file number 34436 in the office of the City Comptroller); and

W H E R E A S, on the 18th day of May, 1908, the City Council adopted the report of said Committee;

NOW THEREFORE, Be it RESOLVED by The City of Seattle, as follows:

1st. That the Board of Public Works in the City of Seattle be and it is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of The City of Seattle with Alaska-Yukon-Pacific Exposition, a corporation, for the loan to said Corporation by said City of certain of its water pipes, hydrants and fittings to be used on the grounds of said Corporation during


its exposition in 1909, and that said contract shall contain terms and provisions in compliance with the report of the Fire and Water committee on the petition of said Alaska-Yukon-Pacific Exposition.

Passed by the City Council the *22nd* day of June, 1908, and signed by me in open session in authentication of its passage this *22nd* day of June, 1908.
