RESOLUTION NO. 17664

A RESOLUTION initiating a proceeding for the vacation of The ALLEY in BLOCK 9, PALATINE HILL ADDITION, pursuant to Chapter 156, Laws of 1957, and providing for a hearing thereon.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATTLE:

That a proceeding for the vacation of The ALLEY in BLOCK 9, PALATINE HILL ADDITION, described as follows:

The ALLEY in BLOCK 9, PALATINE HILL ADDITION, as established by Ordinance No. 76517 being the alley between First Avenue Northwest and 2nd Avenue Northwest from West 44th Street to the south line of Lot 4, said Block 9;

is hereby initiated pursuant to Chapter 156, Laws of 1957, and that Tuesday, the 1st day of April, 1958, at the hour of 2:00 o'clock p.m., in the

City Council Chambers in the County-City Building, Seattle, King County, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place when a hearing before the Streets and Sewers Committee of the City Council upon said proposed vacation so initiated will be had and the City Clerk is directed to give twenty (20) days' notice of such hearing by posting in the manner provided by law. A map, indicating the portion of the alley heretofore described, shall be affixed to and become a part of the notice required by law to be posted in a conspicuous place on the alley sought to be vacated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that at least fifteen (15) days before the date fixed for such hearing, the City Engineer shall give notice by mail of the time, place and purpose of such hearing to the owners or reputed owners of all lots, tracts, or parcels of land or other property abutting upon the portion of said alley sought to be vacated, as shown on the rolls of the County Treasurer, directed to the address thereon shown.

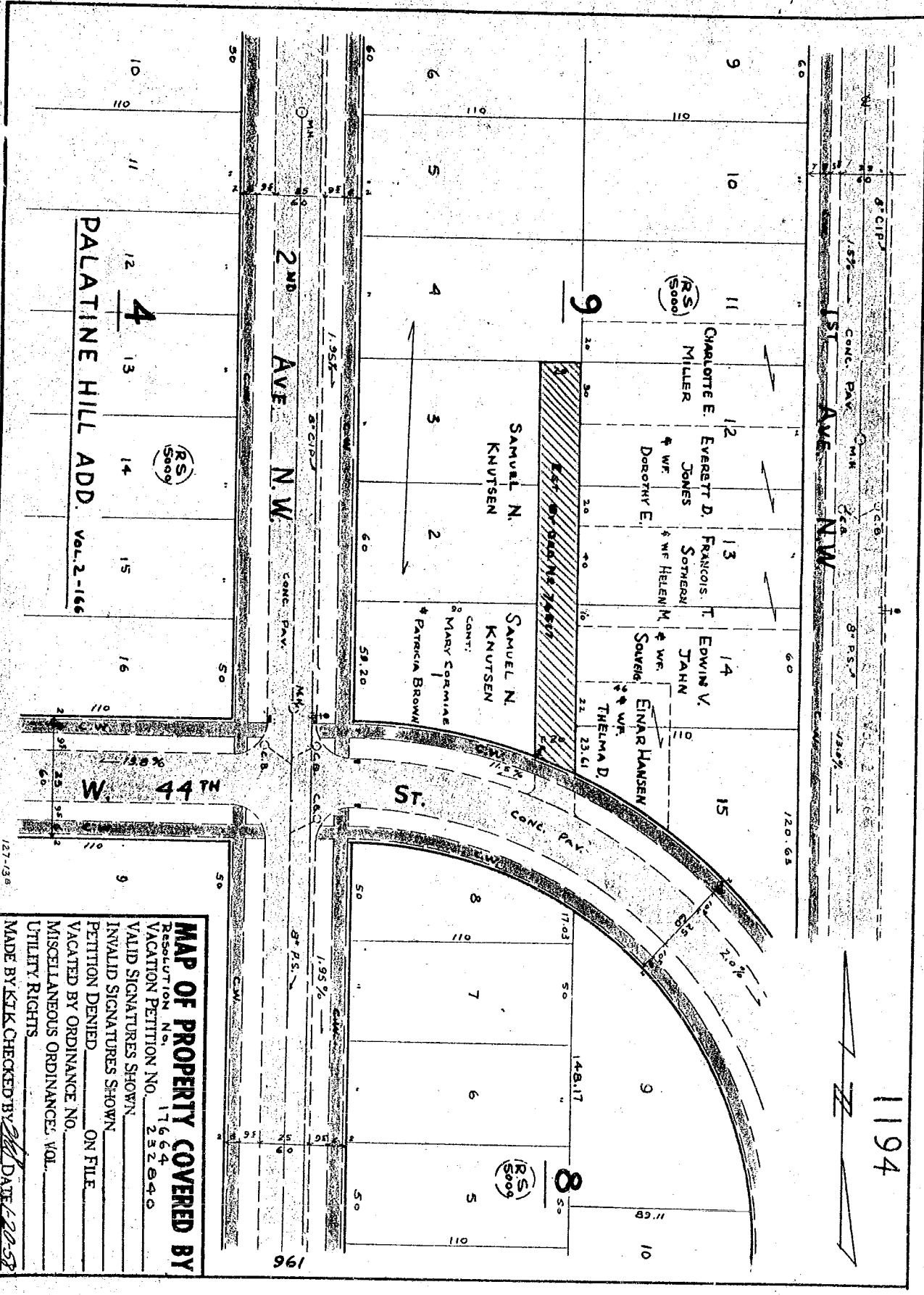
