That the application for a Community Renewal Program grant of \$136,400 for an analysis of the City's total urban renewal requirements for the succeeding ten years prepared under the direction of the Mayor and submitted to the City Council by C. F. 245066 is hereby approved, and the Urban Renewal Coordinator is hereby authorized to file such application with the proper agency of the Federal Government, together with such copies of this resolution and other information and documents as may be required, and otherwise act as the authorized representative of The City of Seattle in such connection.

PASSED the City Council the 16 day of April, 1962, and signed by me in open session in authentication of its passage this 16 day of April, 1962.


