RESOLUTION 20179

A RESOLUTION approving procedures now available for reviewing complaints against Police Department personnel.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has advised (C. F. 252870) that the following officers and agencies will review and cause to be investigated any complaint alleging misconduct on the part of any member of the Seattle Police Department: The Chief of Police of The City of Seattle or any supervising officer in his Department; the Mayor of The City of Seattle; the Prosecuting Attorney for King County; the United States Attorney for Western Washington and the Federal Bureau of Investigation; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATTLE:

That the Council finds that existing public officers, offices and agencies available to individuals desiring to make complaint of the conduct of any member of the Seattle Police Department are adequate to provide a full review and investigation of such alleged misconduct and that there is no necessity at this time for establishment of additional boards or officers to protect the public in such connection.
