RESOLUTION NO. 1206

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:


That there be and hereby is extended a cordial invitation to the Grand Army of the Republic to hold its National encampment in the City of Seattle during the Alaska-Yukon-Pacific Exposition in 1909, and that this Council join with the commercial clubs and other organizations of the City in an earnest endeavor to secure for the City of Seattle the meeting of the National encampment of the G. A. R. during said exposition, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the delegates from the State of Washington to the G. A. R. Encampment to be held in Minneapolis during the month of August, 1906, be requested to use their best influence and endeavors among the delegates at Minneapolis to secure their support in the selection of the City of Seattle as the place for the meeting of the National encampment for the year 1909.
