McKinney Homeless Assistance Act ("McKinney Act") funds, including funds under the Emergency Shelter Grants Program ("ESGP"), may be awarded;

WHEREAS, in the CHAP, the City is required to describe how the use of McKinney Act funds will be consistent with the CHAP; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATTLE, THE MAYOR CONCURRING, THAT:

The City of Seattle hereby adopts the 1991 Comprehensive Homeless Assistance Plan attached hereto as Exhibit A, and authorizes the Mayor to submit the plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. All 1991 City grant applications for Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Assistance Act funds shall be consistent with the Comprehensive Homeless Assistance Plan hereby adopted.

SUBJECT: Resolution Adopting the 1991 Comprehensive Homeless
Assistance Plan

The attached resolution adopts the City of Seattle's 1991 Comprehensive Homeless Assistance Plan (CHAP). The federal government requires the submittal of the CHAP as a prerequisite to receiving HUD funding under all of the elements of the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Assistance Act. The CHAP includes the characteristics and needs of homeless persons in the City of Seattle, an inventory of emergency shelter programs, the strategies for matching needs of various homeless populations with services, and how the City will use HUD funding to complement and enhance services to homeless persons.

Seattle is one of the most successful cities in the country at competing for McKinney Act funds. Seattle projects that serve the homeless have been awarded over \$18,750,000 in funding commitments over the last three years. The CHAP is an enabling document that identifies the directions for City of Seattle support for projects seeking McKinney Act funding. Primary policy thrusts of the 1991 CHAP include:

- Allocate Emergency Shelter Grant Program funds through a community-based planning process, conducted in Fall and Winter 1990-91 by the Office of Management and Budget.
- Support transitional housing projects, where City housing funds can be leveraged significantly, or the project meets elements of existing homeless or special needs strategies.

- Support SAFAH applications which complement or implement projects funded by City housing programs, or implement key elements of the *Homeless Priority Agenda*.
- Use City staff and resources to promote competitive SRO moderate rehab grant applications to preserve existing Seattle affordable housing stock.
