A RESOLUTION setting the public hearing on the petition of the Seattle Housing Authority for the vacation of streets and alleys in Seattle Housing Authority's Yesler Terrace Community Housing in the First Hill area of Seattle; pursuant to Chapter 35.79 Revised Code of Washington (RCW) and Seattle Municipal Code (SMC) 15.62 (Clerk File 311389).

WHEREAS, the Seattle Housing Authority has filed a petition with the City Council to vacate public property; and

WHEREAS, the petition is signed by the owners of more than two-thirds of the property abutting on the subject vacation areas; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATTLE, THAT:

Section 1. A hearing for the vacation of the streets and alleys in the Yesler Terrace Community Housing described as:

<u>Terry Avenue</u> - From the southern right-of-way margin of Alder Street to the western right-of-way margin of Broadway.

<u>Spruce Street</u> - From the northeastern right-of-way margin of 9th Avenue to the western right-of-way margin of Broadway.

<u>Alley in Block 84 of the Terry's 2nd Addition plat</u> - Alley from the northern right-of-way margin of Spruce Street to approximately 60-feet north of the northern right-of-way margin of Spruce Street.

Spruce Street and 9th Avenue Intersection - A portion of the northwest corner of the intersection of Spruce Street and 9th Avenue to remove the radius.

<u>Alley at Yesler Terrace Steam Plant</u> - From the eastern right-of-way margin of 8th Avenue to the southern right-of-way margin of Spruce Street.

8th Avenue Intersection - A portion of the northwest corner of the intersection of 8th Avenue and Yesler Way to remove the radius.

8th Avenue South - From the southern right-of-way margin of Yesler Way to the eastern right-of-way margin of Interstate 5.

<u>South Main Street</u> - From the eastern right-of-way margin of Interstate 5 to the western right-of-way margin of 10th Avenue South.

9th Avenue South - From the southern right-of-way margin of South Main Street to approximately 90-feet south of the southern right-of-way margin of South Main Street.

<u>South Washington Street</u> - From the eastern right-of-way margin of 10th Avenue South to the western right-of-way margin of 12th Avenue South.


