RESOLUTION NO. 4160

Proposed AMENDMENT NO. 2

RESOLUTION and PROPOSITION to amend Section 2 of Article XXIII of the charter relating to the payment of the minimum wage by contractors and sub-contractors in the City of Seattle, and submitting such proposed amendment to the qualified electors of the city at the general municipal election to be held March ^{3rd} 1914.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATTLE:

That Section 2 of Article XXIII of the city charter be amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE XXIII.

Section 2. Every contractor and sub-contractor performing any local or other improvement work for the City of Seattle, or having any contract from the city for any purpose requiring labor to perform it, shall pay or cause to be paid to his employes on such work or under such contract not less than the current rate of wages paid by the City of Seattle for work of like character and in any event not less than two and seventy-five hundredths dollars (\$2.75) per day. Such contractor and sub-contractor shall on such work or under such contract give preference to resident laborers. This article shall be enforced by the City Council by ordinance,

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such proposed amendment be submitted to the qualified electors of the city for their ratification or rejection at the next general municipal election to be held in the City of Seattle on the 3rd day of March, 1914.
