



AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of the Department of Finance and Administrative Services or the Director's designee to execute a lease with the Department of the Army for the City's continued use of an approximately 13,000-square-foot warehouse facility at 1561 Alaskan Way South for the operation of the St. Martin de Porres Shelter for homeless men over the age of 50; and ratifying and confirming certain prior acts.
