3. ELECTION OF SEATTLE TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT DISTRICT BOARD CHAIR AND VICE-CHAIR

Board member Conlin called for the elections of Chair of the Seattle Transportation Benefit District Board.

Motion was made by Board member Licata and duly seconded, to nominate Board member Rasmussen as Chair of the Seattle Transportation Benefit District Board.

Hearing no further nominations, nominations were closed.

The Motion carried and Board member Rasmussen was elected as Chair of the Seattle Transportation District Board by the following voice vote:

Motion was made by Board member Conlin, duly seconded and carried, to amend the proposed Bylaws, in Article II – Powers and Duties, section 2.1.a, by deleting "The Chair shall not be the same person as the Mayor of the City of Seattle."

Motion was made and duly seconded to adopt the Bylaws as amended.

The Motion carried and the Bylaws were adopted as amended by the following voice vote:

Against: None.

The Chair signed the Bylaws.


