As provided for in SMC 2.08, Initiative Petitions, and the City of Seattle Office of the City Clerk Initiative Petition Guide, the petition will be in acceptable form once the following edits are made to the final petition:

- 1. SMC 2.08.010 states the petition shall be typewritten and in a readable font; the use of no less than 10-point font in all petition sections is recommended.
- 2. The petition pages contain the warning language required by SMC 2.08.040 and RCW 35.21.005(2); a reorder of the text as prescribed by the code is recommended.

Please be advised the proposed initiative measure was transmitted to the City Attorney's Office for review and preparation of a ballot title. The Office of the City Clerk will be in contact with you in writing and by telephonic notification no later than the end of business on Thursday, February 3, 2022, for the purpose of transmitting the final ballot title.
