
Form of Petition:

- a. A column for "Date Signed" is not present and should be added.
- b. The "Date of Birth" column is not required and should be omitted.
- c. Past petition forms have been on 11x17 paper, which is the largest acceptable paper size, and it is recommended the petitions be printed on that paper size.
- d. Please consider using at least a 10 point size font for the average person to read it. It is acceptable for the full measure to be on multiple pages.
- e. Each page should have at least 1 inch top margins.

Please be advised the proposed initiative measure was transmitted to the City Attorney's Office for review and preparation of a ballot title. The Office of the City Clerk will be in contact with you in writing and by telephonic notification no later than the end of business on Wednesday, March 15, 2017, for the purpose of transmitting the final ballot title.
